

Troubleshooting - Security Notice opening TDO

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Overview

If the following message pops up while TDO is initializing, please follow the detailed instructions to resolve



Why does this occur?

TDO is opening in the wrong version of Access. TDO uses the MS Access Runtime (either 2002 or 2010), but it is likely opening in the Microsoft Office version of Access.

The easiest way to avoid this issue would be to avoid installing Microsoft Access when installing the Microsoft Office Suite

Note: Microsoft Office 2013 does not by default, allow you to change what programs are installed. To download a custom installer, please have your IT professional check the Microsoft website: [http://technet.microsoft.com/en-us/library/ee460874\(v=office.15\).aspx](http://technet.microsoft.com/en-us/library/ee460874(v=office.15).aspx)

Detailed Instructions

- Close TDO
- Open the **Control Panel** and then select **Uninstall a Program**. This will bring you to a list of all programs installed on the computer.

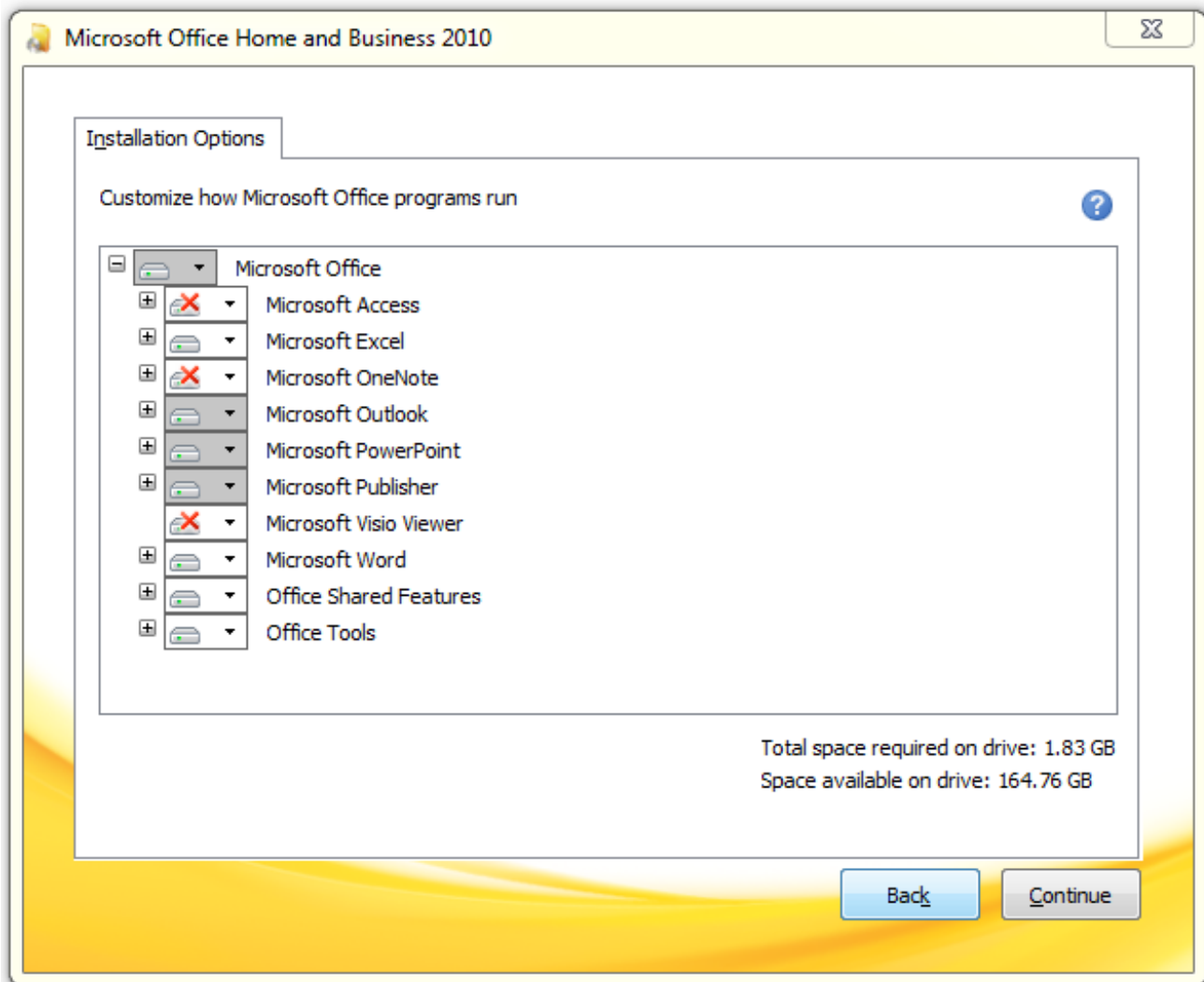
- Select the Microsoft Access Runtime (2002 or 2010) and click **Uninstall**
- After this has been completed, find the version of the Microsoft Office suite installed on the computer. Looking at the image below, the 2010 Office Suite is installed

Uninstall or change a program

To uninstall a program, select it from the list and then click Uninstall, Change, or Repair.

- Select the Office version, and click **Change**
- This will bring up a list of Microsoft Office programs



- Make sure that if MS Access is on the list, that it is marked as **Not Available**. If it is not, click Microsoft Access and change to **Not Available**
- After this, the computer may prompt you to Reboot in order to finalize the change. If it does, go ahead.
- Browse to the **TDO Builds** folder on the mapped server drive, and run **SetupRuntime.exe**
- After the Runtime setup completes, run the **TDO Autofix** and the issue should be resolved

Important Note

After following these steps, run Windows Updates.

If none of the above works, please have your IT do the following

1. Open the registry
2. Go to the following Key Location:
 - a. [HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Microsoft\Office\14.0\Access\Security\Trusted Locations\LocationTDO]
3. If the “LocationTDO” is not present, please go ahead and create it.
 - a. Dword – AllowSubFolders should = 1
 - b. String – Path = C:\Program Files (x86)\TDOOffice – 64 bit
 - i. C:\Program Files\TDOOffice – 32 bit
