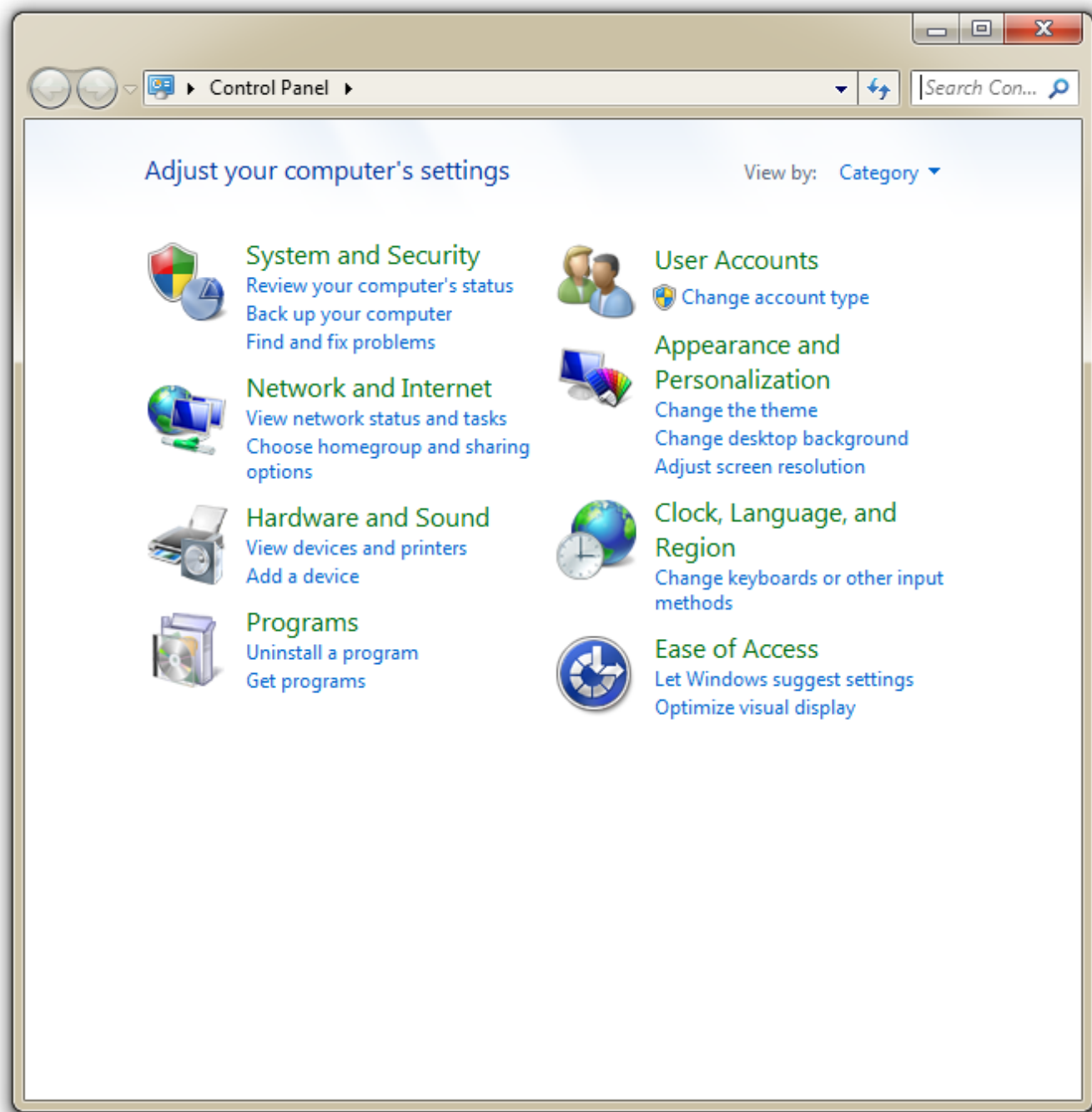
Overview

In order for TDO to function properly, we ask that all firewalls on individual machines be turned off.

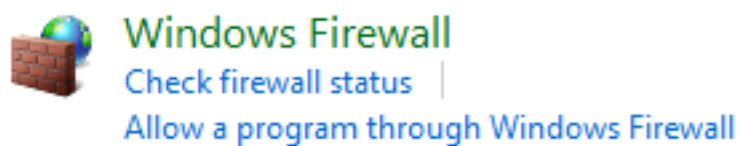
Detailed Instruction

Open **Control Panel**

Click **System and Security**



Click **Windows Firewall**



Click **Turn Windows Firewall on or off** (on the left hand side)

Windows Firewall can help prevent hackers or malicious software from gaining access to your computer through the Internet or a network.

Domain networks

Connected

Networks at a workplace that are attached to a domain

Windows Firewall state:	On
Incoming connections:	Block all connections to programs that are not on the list of allowed programs
Active domain networks:	tdo-office.com
Notification state:	Notify me when Windows Firewall blocks a new program

Home or work (private) networks

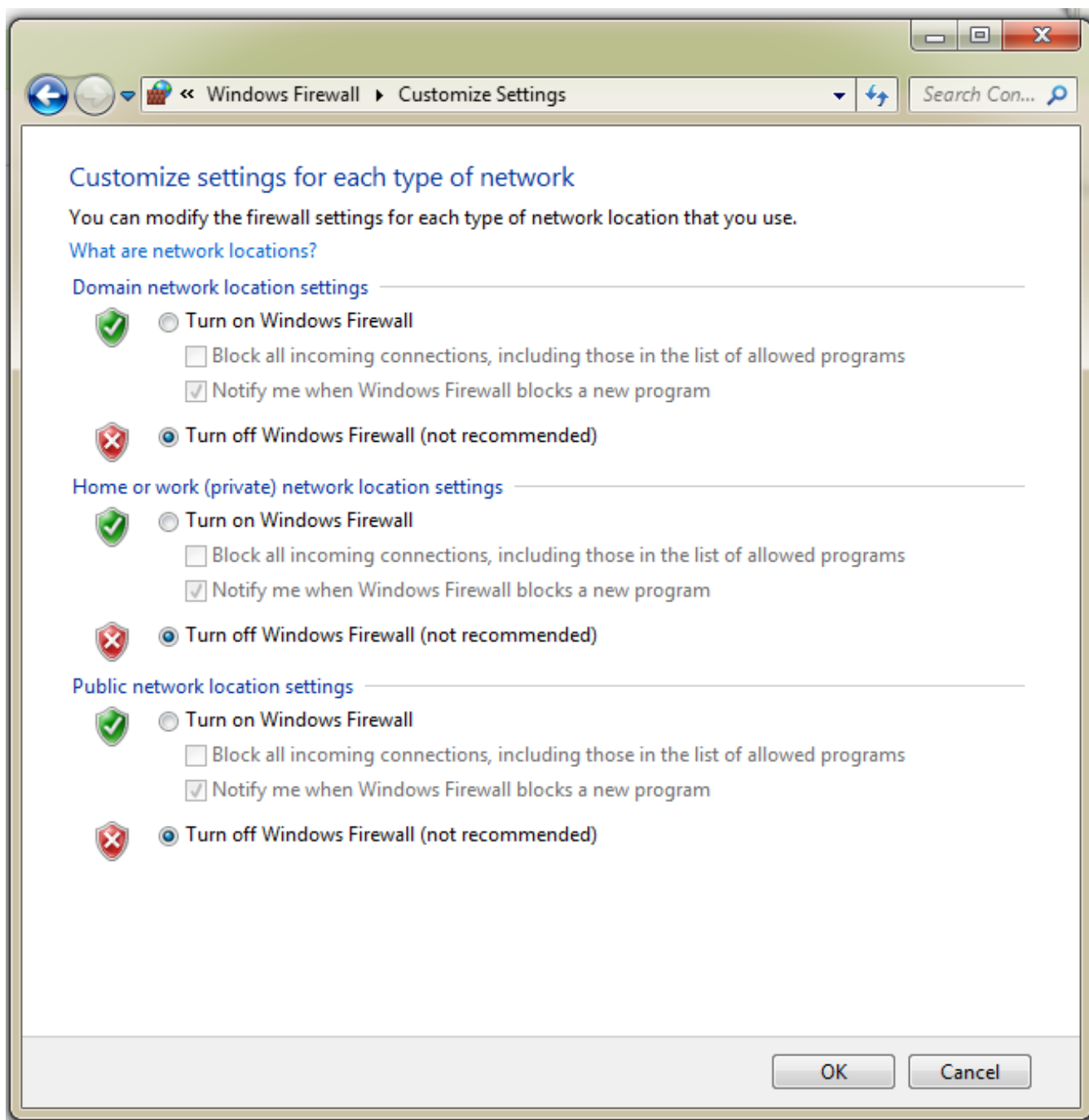
