TDO requires SMTP Authentication for emails to be sent out.

You will need to log in to your GoDaddy account to access these settings.

Once SMTP Authentication is enabled you will need to finish the setup in TDO.

Requirements

Minimum **TDO Version: 12.350** or newer which will support TLS 1.2

"For Windows 7 clients that connect to Office 365, make sure that TLS 1.2 is the default secure protocol in WinHTTP in Windows. For more information see [KB 3140245 - Update to enable TLS 1.1 and TLS 1.2 as a default secure protocols in WinHTTP in Windows](#)"

[How to configure SMTP settings to send emails from TDO](#) will be the next step in TDO for emails to send.

The settings should be:

- **Server name - smtp.office365.com**
- **Port: 587**
- **Checkmark Require TLS Connection**
- **Author Name**
- **Author Email**
- **Username**
- **Password**
